Mini Grant Opportunities for
Local Early Childhood Education Programs



GoAEYC wants to help you celebrate the Week of the Young Child this April 8-12, 2019. The Week of the Young Child is about celebrating young children and their families with hands-on, collaborative activities encouraging movement and healthy lifestyles through music, food, and art. In celebration of Week of the Young Child, and NAEYC's goal to reflect excellence in all aspects of organizational health and vitality*, GoAEYC invites area early childhood programs to apply for a one-time mini grant to support projects specific to their programs.

Applications should be submitted for a specific themed day, not the entire week. You may improve your chances of being awarded a mini grant by applying for different days. The applicant completing the form must be either an Entry, Standard or Premium member of GoAEYC. There will be only one awarded applicant per center location. As an awarded mini grant participant, you will be required to take photos of your activities so that GoAEYC may feature the awarded mini grant programs on our website, on social media and in our newsletter.

Grants up to \$150 each will be awarded to five different programs, and may be used for a specific themed day as outlined on the attached application. Applications must be received by December 1, 2018 to info@goaeyc.org. Applicants will be chosen by GoAEYC's executive board, who will be judging applications based on innovation and creativity. Awarded applicants will be notified by January 15, 2019 and funds released to programs the week of January 21, 2019 after a signed agreement is completed.
